**ABOUT SCNC**

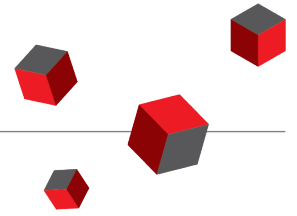
