



Soaring Skills - UA Canada

UA Canada's Soaring Skills Program and the Construction Foundation of BC's (CFBC) Indigenous Skills Program are providing Indigenous students with Try-A-Trade® and Technology kits, which will be mailed directly to their school!

The UA Canada kit will include a build-your-own headphone stand made from threaded pipe nipples and fittings, a set of new Bluetooth headphones, information pamphlets, links to video tutorials and some UA Canada swag! This will provide an opportunity to students who do not have the chance to see the event in person to get a taste of what it's like to build



a project from start to finish using real piping materials, a blueprint and have a great useable keepsake afterwards to inspire them to enter the piping trades.

> The CFBC Indigenous Skills kit will include a Paddle Pendant finishing kit, Indigenous Skills Project Book, video tutorials and more! The paddle pendant workshop will teach students to shape and form wood projects using a variety of techniques. It is a fantastic starting point to working with wood and can

be modified to suit any grade level from Kindergarden to Grade 12! This project can also be used as a part of the Applied Design, Skills and Technologies curriculum or to explore other subjects such as language & culture, social studies and science.

This Try-a-Trade® and Technology package is available to Indigenous and First Nations Schools across the province of BC for students from Grade 9 to 12 and is on a first come first serve basis. Teacher registration is required. Registration closes on May 13, 2022
