- Employers report that graduates entering their workplace have only 30% of the Skills for Success needed for the job.
- It is estimated that 25% of the Canadian manufacturing workforce will retire by 2030.
- Building a better workforce means tapping into more diverse labour pools, such as newcomers to Canada, Indigenous youth, and cross-sectoral labour mobility.
