## 1 COMPETITION SCENARIO

Having completed the morning project, you return from lunch to find several **urgent support tickets** in the helpdesk system. According to notes left in the internal chat logs, the senior network administrator at UltraCorp was **performing unscheduled changes** this morning — and has since **left for vacation** with no handover or documentation.

Unfortunately, several key services are now broken or unreachable, and end-users are growing impatient. You've been tasked with responding to these incidents before the end of the day.

Your role is to **diagnose and resolve issues** across the MidCorp environment using only the access and information available to you. All tickets are tied to business-critical services, so while quick fixes may work in the short term, your final solutions **must reflect real-world best practices** and be ready for long-term use.

As these incidents are significant in both volume and severity, you have also been asked to fill out an incident report that can be presented to your technical lead later this afternoon for further analysis. Each incident must have a single identified root cause and resolution. Ensure that you consider business best practices; the easiest solution may not be the best one within a production environment.

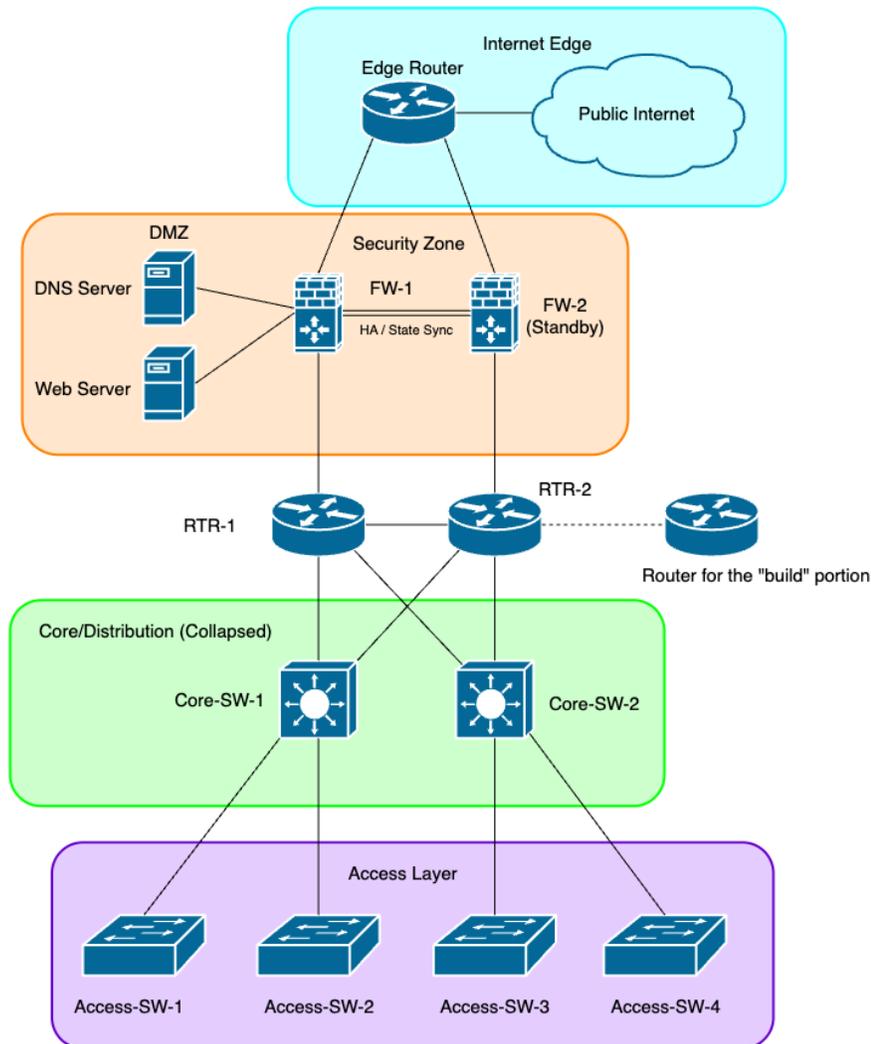
## 2 REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

You must hand in the following documentation in a Microsoft Word-compatible format:

1. The document must be titled **NET-TSHOOT-[PROVINCE]-[NAME]**
2. 2 labeled screenshots per ticket (12 screenshots total)
  - a. 1 screenshot demonstrating successful ticket resolution by showing the output of the relevant 'show' command
  - b. 1 screenshot showing the command that resolved the issue

You must also hand in this paper document with the last page filled out and your name and province written on the cover.

- 4.5 All client and addressing is static and can be assumed to be correct. You will not need to change any client or server addressing to resolve any incidents.
- 4.6 No significant underlying changes within the environment (installing new network hardware, changing or adding VLANs, cabling changes, etc.) will be required.
- 4.7 Due to simulation limitations, all websites are available via HTTP only
