

Instructions for Cabinetmaking Skill #24

1. All dovetail joints must be made completely with hand tools- no power tools allowed.
2. All dovetail, mortice and tenon, and dowel joints must be submitted for marking before being assembled with glue.
3. All measurements are considered accurate on the drawing +/-1mm.
4. Even numbered competitors (benches 2, 4, 6, etc) will complete (including sanding) the stand by the end of day 1.
5. Odd numbered competitors (benches 1, 3, 5, etc) will complete (including sanding) the cabinet, shelf and the cornice assembly (minus the door) by the end of day 1.
6. Any extra time on day 1 and all of day 2 can be used to work on any remaining aspects to complete the project.
7. Post Secondary competitors must complete veneer matching on the door panel. Secondary competitors will use a pre -prepared door panel.
8. Post secondary competitors will use cherry for all solid wood components. Secondary competitors will use alder for all solid components of this project.

If competitors choose to bring their projects home, packaging and shipping are the competitor's responsibility.
